



Mudroom Bench: Cut List

Items you'll need:

- 2 sheets of 4'x8' MDF (medium density fibreboard) or plywood, $\frac{3}{4}$ " width
- 6 or 7 – 8' lengths of 1x2" primed pine trim boards (depending on your propensity for error)
- 1 panel of laminated pine or individual boards you can join together to make the top of the bench seat
- $\frac{3}{4}$ " trim piece for edge of laminated pine
- Optional: smooth 1/4" (approx.) board to put on the back of your unit, unless you have nice smooth walls
- Optional: quarter round
- Wood glue
- Nail gun/compressor and various lengths of nails
- Wood screws (1 1/2" and 3")
- Primer
- Semi-gloss paint
- Wood fill
- Baskets to fit lower cubbies and overhead storage
- 6' length of crown molding
- 5' length of brick molding
- 5' length of cove molding
- 3 – 8' lengths of 1"x3" boards (MDF or pine or primed boards are fine, avoid curved edges)
- Hooks
- Approx. 12' lattice boards – this is a trim piece that is about 1/4" x 1 3/8"
